Their parents are private guides and the owners of The Safari Collection and its properties – Giraffe Manor, Sasaab, Solio Lodge and Sala's Camp. As the fifth generation of Carr-Hartley's they have a strong heritage in wildlife and safaris, with their ancestors paving the way for wilderness adventures in East Africa. Ever present at their parents' sides, they have been heading into Kenya's 'bush' since they were weeks old. Opposite you will find 3 sample days of the Sasaab kid's program designed by the newest generation of the famous Carr-Hartley clan.

Fun in the sun swimming and playing. Then gather in the car and head for sundowner rock. Climb up the rock to play spot the wildlife on the plains and see the sun disappear into the evening sky. Then enjoy a picnic supper of freshly made lasagna and toasted marshmallows. On the way back to the lodge, enjoy a night game drive.



DAY TWO

Leave early for the Samburu National Park. Enjoy a picnic breakfast watching herds of giraffe and elephants crossing the river. After swimming and lunch, it is time to ride a camel. With three to a camel, there are lots of laughs. Come back with stories of being attacked by the thorn bushes and playing in the mud. Then back to the lodge for fish and chips before bed.



DAY THREE

To Sasaab village to play with the village children in their houses. Back at the lodge enjoy swimming, painting and scooters. Then it's down to the river with the Samburu warriors and guides, where you can show off your bow and arrow skills or make sand castles. Then it is time for the Samburu Olympics, with running and jumping in the sand.
