A maximum of 8 guests will be allowed on a walking safari with a minimum age allowed on walks of 12 years old. All walks have 2 rifles (caliber 458 or 416 Rigby).

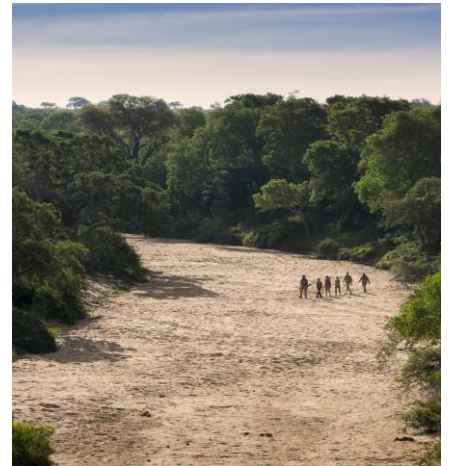
Dale Jackson (Guide)
