Location & Access

Mwiba Lodge overlooks a rocky gorge on the Arugusinyai River, located in a private 129,530-acre wildlife reserve adjoining the southern Serengeti.

ACCESS:

From Arusha Airport or Lake Manyara Airstrip, fly with Northern Air shared charters into Mwiba Airstrip followed by a 15-minute drive to Mwiba Lodge.

Ndutu Airstrip is a 2-hour game drive away, and the Ngorongoro Crater is a 5 to 6-hour drive from Mwiba Lodge.
