RHINO CONSERVATION WEEK: 1 week per year 21 rhinos in 7 days: an intensive rhino conservation week during which all Marataba guests take part in rhino monitoring, DNA collection and notching. CONSERVATION EVENTS: Large scale megafauna notching, collaring and/or relocations. Variable surcharges

*NOTE: All wildlife interventions are undertaken for conservation reasons only and animal welfare is of primary concern. All funds raised are used to finance the operation and species-specific conservation objectives. Wildlife interventions are carefully planned and have to be pre-booked and considered.

TRANSFERS

BY ROAD: The nearest airport is Lanseria International Airport (HLA), a 3-hour drive, or O.R. Tambo International Airport (JNB), a 3½ hour drive. Road access is either via self-drive or private road transfer.

BY AIR: There are daily flights from Lanseria (HLA) to Marakele (1 hour), and 3 flights a week from the Sabi Sands (1hr 30m). The airstrip is directly adjacent the park and a 10-minute drive from the Conservation Camps. Transfers from the airstrip are complimentary, in open vehicles.

RATES INCLUDE:

- Accommodation as specified, transfers to/from the lodge airstrip and VAT.
- All meals, soft drinks, South African premium & sparkling wines, local & premium brand spirits, beers, & game drive refreshments.
- Exclusive safari vehicle and dedicated conservation guide per booking.
- General and conservation safari activities: Day and night game drives | Boating | Wild walking & hiking safaris | Family-friendly nature walk | Rhino conservation & ear notch ID | Camera trap set up & analysis | Wildlife interventions | Predator management | Elephant management | Ecology experiences | Area integrity & protection | Community outreach | Mindfulness

RATES EXCLUDE:

- Conservation & Community Levy per person per night.
- Champagne, telephone calls, laundry, gratuities, all items of a personal nature and emergency medical evacuation insurance.
- Additional activities not mentioned on the rate inclusions (annual & special experiences).

CHILDREN:

- Children of all ages are welcome at Marataba Conservation Camps.
- Conservation & Community Levy: complimentary for children under 2 years, 50% of adult rate for children 2-15 years.
- Cots are available for ages 0 – 2 years at no additional charge. Stretcher beds are available for ages 2 – 15 years; 50% child rate applies. Maximum 2 children sharing per room. Note: stretcher beds and cots are limited across camps.
- While both camps are fenced, wildlife may enter the camp and children's safety remains the full responsibility of parents at all times.
- Explorers Camp, with its dedicated family tent, is particular well suited to younger guests.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Rates are quoted in South African Rand (ZAR) and include VAT. Rates are reviewed quarterly and are subject to change.
- A minimum stay of 3 nights is required for all bookings, allowing 2 full days for guests to immerse themselves in the conservation experience.
- Upon enquiry, bookings will be held for 14 days after which they are either confirmed or released.
- Once confirmed, the booking is held with **no deposit required** on a status of **'confirmed without commitment fee'**, until any of the following becomes true:
 - The booking is cancelled in writing by the agent.
 - Another request is received with overlapping dates. At such a time, a **20% non-refundable commitment fee** is required within 48 hours to confirm the booking and prevent Marataba Conservation Camps from releasing the space to another booking. At this stage, the booking status changes to **'confirmed with commitment'**.
 - At 45 days prior to travel when the full payment is due, and the booking is **'confirmed with full-payment'**.
- Final payment is due 45 days prior to arrival - 100% of the reservation value is due if no commitment fee was called, or balance of 80% of the total reservation value when a commitment fee has been paid.
- All commitment fees and full payments are held in a separate call account and do not become part of the operational cash flow until the guest has stayed.
- The amount stated on the invoice is what must be received by Marataba Conservation Camps nett of bank charges / credit card fees.

CANCELLATIONS:

- Cancellations must be received and acknowledged by Marataba Conservation Camps in writing.
- **'Confirmed without commitment fee'**: bookings carry no cancellation fees up to 46 days prior to arrival.
- **'Confirmed with commitment'** OR **'confirmed with full-payment'**: In the event of any reservation being cancelled after Marataba Conservation Camps has issued a confirmation, for any reason other than a WHO-recognised pandemic that impacts the booking, the following cancellation fees will apply:
 - **'Confirmed with commitment'**: if cancelled between confirmation and 46 days prior to arrival, the 20% commitment fee is forfeited.
 - **'Confirmed with full-payment'**: if cancelled between 45 days prior to arrival, the full reservation value is forfeited.

PANDEMIC DISCLAIMER:

- Marataba Conservation Camps will allow postponement of a booking for up to 12 months, if travel is cancelled with a commitment fee or 45 days or less prior to arrival due to a WHO-recognised pandemic directly impacting the guests' ability to travel (e.g. lockdown, no flights, guest not allowed to board a flight, guest falls ill due to a pandemic and unable to travel).
- In the event of a WHO-recognised pandemic directly impacting the ability of Marataba Conservation Camps to meet its obligations with respect to the booking, all monies received, including the commitment fee, will be fully refunded (e.g. lockdown in RSA, government restrictions on trade).
- Any refund is given at the discretion of Marataba Conservation Camps management.
- All travellers are advised to take out fully comprehensive travel insurance with 'cancellation for no reason'. This insurance must be able to fully cover cancellation of travel fewer than 60 days prior to arrival.
